



KEY-TECH Compliance statement Regarding REACH

We, Key-tech Electronic Systems (hereinafter referred to as Key-tech), are aware of REACH as a European community regulation on chemicals.

Currently Key-tech supports the underlying goals of REACH which is to ensure a high level of protection to human health and the environment, which are consistent with our commitment to promote the responsible use and handling of hazardous materials and substances. Under these conditions, Key-tech confirms and certifies the following.

Key-tech is neither a manufacturer nor importer of preparations into Europe and therefore the registration requirements do not apply to us. It is expected that any electronic materials manufacturer that use preparations from Europe in their products will ensure compliance with REACH registration requirements.

Product (articles) manufacturers or importers into Europe are obligated under article 33 of REACH to inform recipients of any articles that contain chemicals on the Substance of Very High Concern (SVHC) candidate list above a concentration (by weight per article). Products manufactured by Key-tech **do not** contain substances on the REACH SVHC candidate list in concentrations greater than 0.1% by weight per article.
